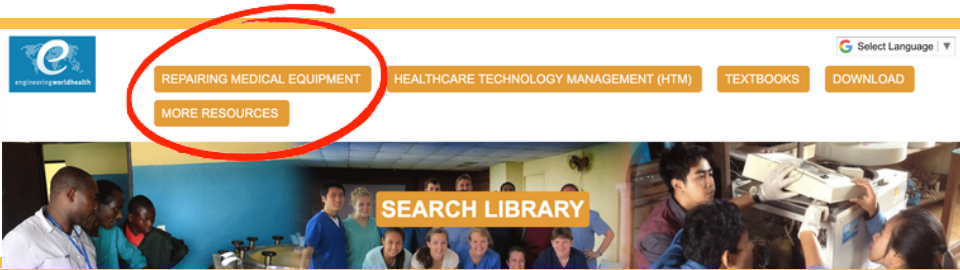
What is the BMET Library?

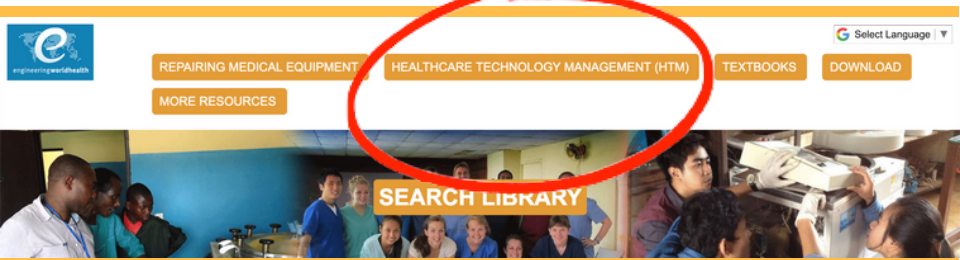
